Investigative Action: Christian Colleges & Universities That Support Planned Parenthood in the United States

Overview

The *Pro-Life Generation's* (PLG) *Demetree Institute for Pro-Life Advancement* investigated 732 colleges and universities affiliated with Christian churches in the United States for the fourth year in a row, finding that 83, or **one in eleven Christian schools**, maintain some type of relationship with *Planned Parenthood*, the nation's largest abortion vendor.

In the continuing wake of *Roe v. Wade*'s reversal, Christian schools are choosing to fall in with the Culture of Death, instead of holding fast to Christian teaching which calls them to protect the vulnerable.

As noted, *Planned Parenthood* is the nation's largest abortion vendor. According to the organization's own 2023 <u>annual report</u>, *Planned Parenthood* ended the lives of at least 392,715 preborn children through abortion violence last year.

New findings by the *Demetree Institute for Pro-Life Advancement* uncover the sad reality that Christian schools have steadily increased their support of *Planned Parenthood* by 10% each year since 2022. An additional investigation into each school's staffing revealed a startling number of professors with individual connections to the abortion industry, hinting at a more insidious problem brewing at Christian schools that suggests their staffing choices do not reflect the foundational values of their institutions. This year's report takes a deeper look into where exactly so many Christian schools are missing the mark with several factors at play.

The goal of the *Christian Schools Project* is to raise public awareness of the reality that Christian schools have ties to *Planned Parenthood* and the abortion industry so that change can be made. Without this strategy, the future of Christian schools may look even more bleak. At the time of publication, **twelve ties between Christian schools** and *Planned Parenthood* were severed during 2023-2024, thanks to interventions and awareness facilitated by the *Christian Schools Project*.

Key Findings - 2024 Report

- Christian schools' **support for abortion increased annually by 10%** since 2022 in the wake of *Roe*'s reversal.
- **One in eleven Christian schools** maintained some type of relationship with *Planned Parenthood*.
- **Nearly half** (42%) of the infractions overall were Christian schools referring students to *Planned Parenthood* as a "health resource."
- **12 Christian schools removed ties** to the abortion industry after initial contact with researchers in 2024. **54 total connections have been severed** since the start of this study in 2021.
- **65 professors** at Christian schools have a connection to the abortion industry through events or publications and **14** of those professors have been directly affiliated with abortion industry leaders like *Planned Parenthood* through previous employment or board positions.
- Christian schools earning an "A+" grade by supporting their local **Pregnancy Help Center increased 32%.**

Methodology

Research was spearheaded by the *Pro-Life Generation's* (PLG) Strategic Initiatives Team throughout the 2023-2024 school year.

For the scope of this research, a "Christian school" was defined as an institution of higher education affiliated with a Christ-centered denomination and publicly claiming historical Christian faith in its founding. SFLA identified 732 colleges and universities in the United States that aligned with this definition. To compile this list, SFLA referred to established online resources such as <u>Niche's 2024 Best Christian Colleges in America</u> and the <u>USCCB's Catalog of Catholic Colleges and Universities in the United States</u>.

Additionally, each institution's mission statement and historical background were reviewed to ensure their identification with Christian values before inclusion in the final list of 732 Christian colleges and universities.

The number of Christian schools on the 2024 list is slightly fewer than the 2023 report due to school closures and some schools dropping of their faith affiliation.

To assess a school's connection to *Planned Parenthood* or the abortion industry in general, researchers conducted a thorough analysis of the school's website. Once a connection to *Planned Parenthood* or abortion was identified, a time-stamped screenshot was captured and saved to prove the location and type of infraction. It was also researched and documented whether the school had connections to nonviolent abortion alternatives, such as local Pregnancy Help Centers.

Final research was confirmed throughout June 2024, and outreach to the school was conducted between July 1— July 30, 2024. Respective school administrations or related academic departments were contacted via phone and email. Our team informed them of

the identified infractions, in case they were unaware, and requested the removal of the offending content.

Infraction Categories

An "infraction" denotes a relationship with *Planned Parenthood* or another abortion industry entity. A variety of connections qualified as a "relationship," organized in the following categories:

- An **internship opportunity** that recommended or credited work at *Planned Parenthood* or another local abortion vendor was actively promoted on the school's website.
- *Planned Parenthood* or another local abortion vendor was publicized as a **health resource** where students could procure services.
- Planned Parenthood was identified as a class resource.
- **Events** featuring *Planned Parenthood* or an abortion industry entity from 2020 onward were advertised on the school's website.
- *Planned Parenthood* or another local abortion vendor were discussed/published as a **volunteer opportunity**.
- Planned Parenthood was touted as a future career opportunity.
- The school administration or an academic department (i.e., "Women and Gender Studies") **published direct support** of *Planned Parenthood* or abortion in general.

Christian schools that engaged in the above forms of relationship with the abortion industry were given infractions and assigned a grade ranging from "A+" to "F" based on the number of infractions. Repeated instances of the same type of infraction resulted in separate infraction credit. For example, if there were two different places a pro-abortion internship was promoted, this counted as two separate infractions.

If no infractions were found (resulting in an "A" grade), schools were considered for a promotion to "A+" if the institution also referred pregnant and parenting students to a local Pregnancy Help Center.

Grade	Definition
A+	A school with zero infractions <i>and</i> a relationship with a local, life-affirming Pregnancy Help Center.
A	A school with zero infractions but no proof of relationship with a local, life- affirming Pregnancy Help Center.

Grading Scale

A+ Promotion Opportunity

The research team also emailed all "A" schools to request the promotion of pregnant and parenting student resources to the student body, enabling schools to later join the prestigious "A+ Christian Schools List". To be awarded the "A+ Christian School Award," these Christian colleges were responsible for providing web-based evidence of at least one of the following life-affirming criteria:

• Promotion of their local Pregnancy Help Center as a resource on their website.

- Promotion of job and volunteer opportunities at Pregnancy Help Centers.
- Establishment of scholarships for pregnant and parenting students.

• Partnership with *Standing With You*, an SFLA initiative that supports pregnant and parenting students, by promoting <u>www.standingwithyou.org/</u> as a pregnancy resource.

Key Findings

One in eleven Christian colleges and universities maintain some type of relationship with *Planned Parenthood* and the abortion industry.

Out of the 732 total Christian schools investigated, 87 schools were initially found to have ties with *Planned Parenthood* or support abortion. The schools shared a combined total of 247 infractions, up 33% from last year. See *Appendix A* for the full list of Christian schools with remaining infractions.




Figure 1. Depicts the breakdown of final grades received.

Throughout July 2024, 12 Christian schools with *Planned Parenthood* connections were successfully removed, resulting in 83 schools with a connection (although some schools removed a connection, others remained and therefore have not yet become an "A" school). Of those remaining 83 infracted schools, 24 received a "F" grade (having four or more infractions), 15 received a "D" grade (for three infractions), 20 received a "C" grade (for two infractions), and the remaining 24 schools received a "B" grade (for one infraction). The number of schools receiving an "F" significantly increased by 50%.

There are glimmers of light among the darkness of fading Christian schools. The remaining 649 Christian schools received an "A" or "A+" rating because there were no infractions found on their websites. Within that segment, 58 were promoted to an "A+" for listing their local Pregnancy Help Center on their school website, which was a 32% increase from 2023. See *Appendix A* for a full list of "A" and "A+" schools.

Abortion support has increased at Christian Schools by 10% for the second year in a row.

Our 2023 report found:

With the historical reversal of Roe, the subject of abortion was launched into America's public dialogue at levels likely not seen since 1973. Those "in the middle" were pulled out of their silence, and many forfeited unquestioned abortion support amid hostile environments. Thus, 2022 also became a decision year for Christian schools: to apply or not to apply God's truth on the value of life. In 2021, the conclusion of our Christian school outreach found 69 schools in total having infractions by the end of that year. However, following the Dobbs decision in 2022, schools with infractions skyrocketed back up to 76 in total throughout the following year, increasing by nearly 10%.

One year later, we find Christian schools on the same trajectory, now with 83 infraction schools, another nearly 10% increase.

Undoubtedly, the ever-present abortion lobby's fearmongering during an election season has schools everywhere feeling the pressure. For some Christian schools, however, this meant taking two steps backward by hosting pro-abortion events and earning their first infraction. For instance, *Jarvis Christian University*, a Disciples of Christ school in Texas, downgraded to a "B" after years of earning a perfect score thanks to an election-related event pushing "abortion rights" as a critical issue.



Worse yet, in previous years, most Christian schools were discreet about their promotion of abortion, generally hiding *Planned Parenthood* in places like "Women's Services." However, this year's research has noted schools newly promoting abortion outright.

For example, *Saint Elizabeth University,* a Catholic school in New Jersey, has drastically decreased from an "A" to an "F" due to the number of times they now unashamedly refer students directly to local abortion vendors instead of a Pregnancy Help Center.



Abortion guised as "healthcare" is no longer wordsmithing saved only for secular institutions, but lingo adopted by dozens of Christian schools. In fact, at Christian colleges and universities, the most frequent infraction was *Planned Parenthood* appearing as a "health resource." Almost half (42%) of all documented infractions promoted *Planned Parenthood* to students by listing the abortion vendor as a 'reliable and trusted health resource' either from the school health center's landing page directly or within a linked document of local resources.




Figure 2. Depicts the frequency of the specific type of *Planned Parenthood* infractions among the group of infracted Christian schools.

Wesleyan College, a Methodist school in Georgia, not only refers directly for abortion, but goes so far as to label it "abortion *care*" and urges students to seek abortion quickly before state protections for preborn babies begin.



Georgia's six-week ban on abortions and what that means.

Am I still able to get an abortion?

Yes, you can get an abortion in Georgia up to six weeks after conception. Currently, Georgia has a six-week abortion ban that prohibits most abortions after the fetal cardiac activity is detected in pregnancy. Typically this occurs 6 weeks after your last menstrual period. There are some exceptions, but they are limited. Planned Parenthood can help you access care. Because of the ban, pregnant people do not have much time to get an abortion. It is crucial for you to seek abortion care as soon as possible once you decide to terminate your pregnancy.

Can I still obtain abortion care?

Yes, you can still obtain abortion care in Atlanta up to the legal limit, including care for exceptional cases. Abortion Finder can help you find a location.

Pro-Abortion professors have proven influence on a Christian school's support of *Planned Parenthood*.

While the steady increase of abortion support among Christian schools can likely be attributed to the abortion lobby's alarmism post-*Dobbs*, our 2024 research uncovered another possible connection: their own staff.

Newly investigated in 2024, the Christian Schools Project uncovered 65 professors hired at Christian schools who have individual ties to the abortion industry through previous employment or affiliation with *Planned Parenthood* or publications supporting abortion. It is wishful thinking to assume educators would not allow views antithetical to the Christian schools they represent creep into their classrooms, but a closer look at certain infractions exposed otherwise.

A prime example is *Saint Louis University*, a Catholic school in Missouri that would have otherwise received an "A" grade if not for an event led by Professor Brietta Clark, Professor of Law. Clark's staff biography lists publications in support of what she terms "abortion care" in her article *"Protecting Health After Dobbs.*" Sadly, this professor's support of abortion led to her views infiltrating campus events that also promoted abortion as healthcare.

Dobbs v. Jackson: Implications for Reproduction, Health, and Liberty



Professor Brietta Clark launched this fall's Distinguished Speaker Series with a lecture on Dobbs v. Jackson and how the uncertainty that surrounds its interpretation and application has threatened health equity. SLU LAW students may recognize her name as a co-author of the Health Care Law class casebook.

Professor Clark is now the Dean at yet another Christian school, *Loyola Marymount University School of Law in California,* which means this institution is potentially in danger of losing its "A" status should they, too, allow her influence to pollute their Christian foundation.

Another example comes from the prestigious, *Catholic University of Notre Dame*, which lost its A+ status for the first year ever thanks to the influence of professors within the Gender Studies Department.

At *Notre Dame*, a campus-approved and promoted event featured an "abortion doula" discussing "abortion care" in 2023. As the event description states, "*The <u>Reproductive</u> <u>Justice: Scholarship for Solidarity and Social Change</u> series is sponsored by the <i>Notre Dame Gender Studies Program*," demonstrating the ability for staff's personal opinions to override and influence a Christian school's core values.



Christian schools can make changes before it is too late.

2024 Christian School Victories

Thankfully, several schools responded positively to our outreach this year, swiftly removing some or all instances of an infraction. Sometimes, this resulted in schools elevating back up to an "A" grade, ridding their entire website of all *Planned Parenthood* and abortion references. In other cases, schools with multiple infractions only removed one out of several references, thereby resulting in an improved grade and noted "victory," but not an "A" grade.

While some schools replied to our team's outreach and confirmed the removal of an infraction, other schools appeared to stealthily remove a reference. Upon the deadline provided to schools to have the offending references removed, our team re-researched all infraction links to see if they were still active.

- Chaminade University (Hawaii) Increased from a B grade to an A grade.
 a) Removed Planned Parenthood as a 'health and parenting' resource.
- 2) Felician University (New Jersey) Increased from a B grade to an A grade.
 a) Removed Planned Parenthood as a 'health' resource.
- 3) High Point University (North Carolina) Increased from a B grade to an A grade.
 a) Removed an honoree tied to Planned Parenthood.
- 4) Rocky Mountain College (Montana) Increased from a B grade to an A grade.
 a) Removed Planned Parenthood as an internship opportunity.
- 5) Villanova University (Pennsylvania) Increased from a B grade to an A grade.
 a) Removed Planned Parenthood as a Graduate School health resource.
- 6) University of Indianapolis (Indiana) increased from a C grade to a B grade.
 a) Removed Planned Parenthood as a 'health' resource.
- 7) Moravian University (Pennsylvania) Increased from a D grade to a C grade.
 a) Removed Planned Parenthood as a health resource from their website.
- 8) Southwestern University (Texas) Increased from a D grade to a C grade.
 a) Removed Planned Parenthood as a 'health' resource.
- 9) **Oklahoma City University** (Oklahoma) *Remained a D due to adding and removing a connection.*
 - a) Removed *Planned Parenthood* as a 'health' resource.
- 10) **Duke University** (North Carolina): *Remained an F grade due to more than 4 infractions remaining.*
 - a) Removed *Planned Parenthood* as a volunteer opportunity.
- 11) **Muhlenberg College (**Pennsylvania): *Remained an F grade due to more than 4 infractions remaining.*
 - a) Removed the *Planned Parenthood Federation of America* as a 'self-help' resource.
- 12) **Santa Clara University** (California): *Remained an F grade due to more than 4 infractions remaining.*
 - a) Removed *Planned Parenthood* as a resource concerning consent.

Conclusion

Another year's passage has proven there is no time to waste as the number of Christian schools abandoning the most basic biblical value, the sanctity and intrinsic value of human life, increases at an alarming rate. Supporting and facilitating abortions is neither loving thy neighbor nor educating future disciples on Gospel truths.

The Demetree Institute for Pro-Life Advancement, powered by the Pro-Life Generation, will continue to amplify these issues through the Christian Schools Project, seeking resolutions. In addition, an investment must be made to change culture from within by starting Students for Life groups at every Christian school, which is an essential part of *Students for Life of America*'s National Campus Expansion Plan.

If the pro-life movement wishes to change the entire landscape of higher education in the United States to become life-affirming, it is essential to start with religious schools that already should align with the Christian belief that all life is valuable and worthy of protection.
