What is a GYN Exam?

A gynecologic exam involves an external and internal physical examination of female genitalia. Additionally, a breast exam is often performed for a more comprehensive women's health evaluation. A GYN exam generally includes testing for sexually transmitted infections as well as a Pap Smear (see below). You can make an appointment for a GYN exam online or by calling the Student Health Center. Be sure to specify that you would like a GYN exam because these exams are allotted more

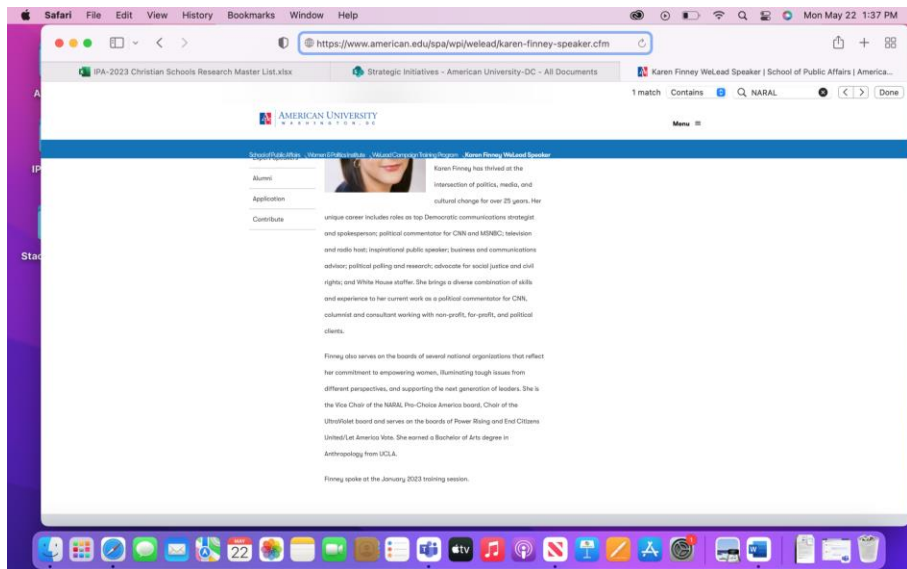
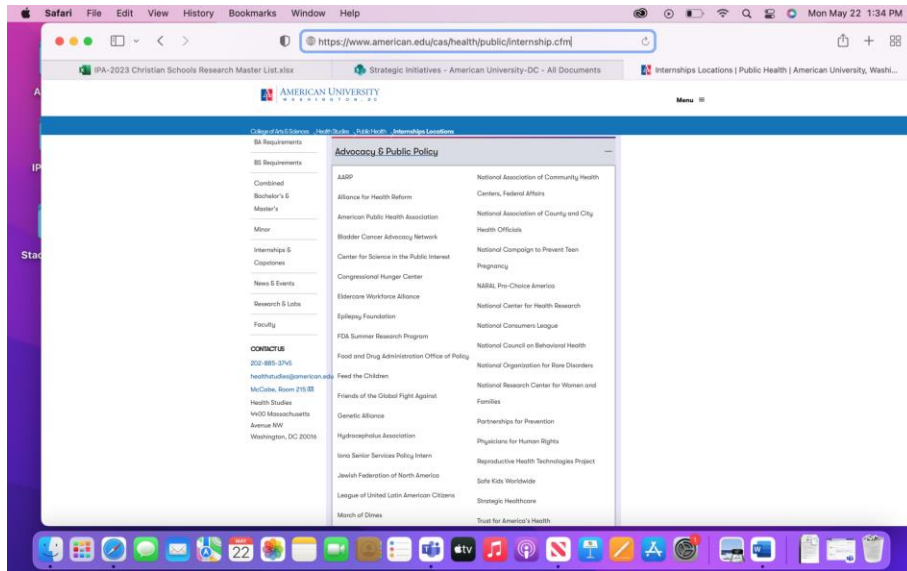

AU Student Activist Gets Face Time with Kamala Harris

Kaniya Harris, CAS-SPA/BA '24, and other student activists visited the White House for a meeting with Vice President Kamala Harris about reproductive rights.

December 6, 2022

On October 14, 2022, Kaniya Harris, CAS-SPA/BA '24, and other student activists met with Vice President Kamala Harris at the White House about reproductive rights. Kaniya Harris—director of AU's Students for Change Initiative and co-leader of the Black Student Union—was among 75 students from 33 states and 66 colleges and universities invited to discuss safeguarding reproductive rights in the wake of the Supreme Court's decision overturning Roe v. Wade.

Here, she talks about her background and the trip to the White House.

I was super excited when I found out I was going to the White House. The first thing I did was call my parents. When I called my great-grandfather, he told me to make the experience count because we don't get a lot of Black women from Kentucky at the White House.

One of the reasons I was chosen is because I lead the Students for Change—formerly known as

This fall, Weitz will launch the [Abortion Information Hub](#) at AU to provide a digital portal to abortion-related information and research. (For more information, email AJH@american.edu.)

At American University, Weitz also serves as director of the [Center on Health, Risk, and Society](#), which was established in 2010 to bring together scholars from across AU schools and disciplines to conduct research on the social and structural contexts that produce health and health-related inequities. CHRS stresses that addressing these inequities requires understanding health as constituted by social, cultural, economic, political, and historical processes. The Center organizes its work around five research foci: Sex, Sexuality, and Reproduction; Migration, Displacement, and Disruption; Violence and the Carceral State; Wellbeing and Social Belonging; and Environment, Climate, and Place.

On Wednesday, September 13, the Center will launch its 2023-2024 weekly speaker series. Samya A. Mojola will discuss "Race, Health, and Inequality: The Roots of the HIV/AIDS Epidemic in Washington, DC." At Princeton University, Mojola is a professor of sociology and public affairs, the Maurice P. During a professor of Demographic Studies, and director of the Office of Population Research. Tracy Weitz's Groundbreaking Appointment to Committee on Reproductive Health, Equity, and Society
Pioneering expert on abortion will advise on reproductive health in United States

This summer, Tracy Weitz was appointed to the National Academies of Science, Engineering and Medicine (NASEM) [Standing Committee on Reproductive Health, Equity, and Society](#). Weitz is an American University professor of sociology and the director of AU's [Center on Health, Risk, and Society](#) (CHRS).

The appointment is groundbreaking. Weitz joins NASEM's very first cohort with expertise on abortion. "When the committee wanted to understand the impact of the Dobbs Supreme Court decision overturning Roe v. Wade, they realized they needed to add scholars focused on abortion-related research," Weitz says. "There were already many distinguished experts on general reproductive health on the committee, but specific social science expertise on abortion in the United States was needed."

Medical follow-up:

- Within 72 hours an individual can be treated prophylactically for certain STDs and pregnancy (if that is a concern). Most hospital ERs offer this treatment; in Cedar Rapids Unity Point Health St. Luke's Hospital and Mercy Medical Center offer emergency pregnancy prophylaxis. Most physician offices, Planned Parenthood, and The Emma Goldman Clinic can also provide this treatment. There may be a charge for this service. Also important is follow-up testing for STDs such as HIV.

Mental health follow-up:

- On-campus free, individual counseling is available to individuals accused of sexual assault, to help deal with feelings related to being accused, decision making, and exploring behaviors such as alcohol use. If appropriate, a referral to an off-campus mental health professional may be provided. You might offer to help an accused friend by being with them when they schedule the first visit. Support persons for those accused of assault may also obtain counseling from the Center. For more information call ext. 4292 (319-895-4292).

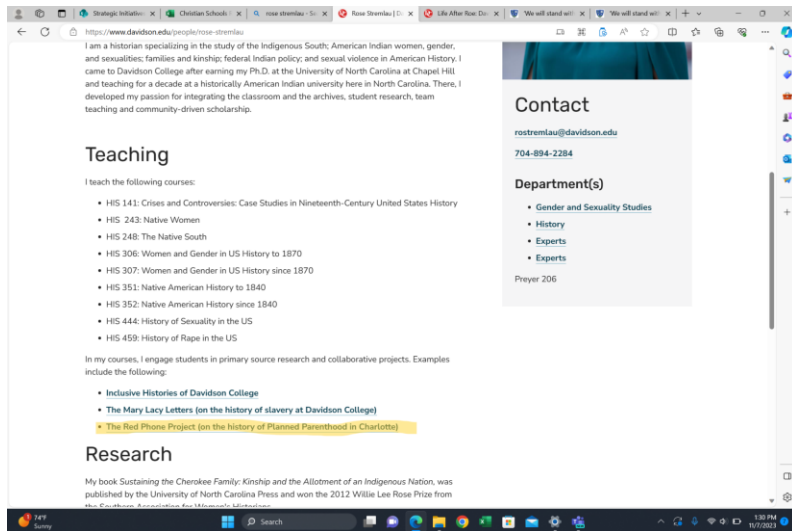

Unplanned Obsolescence: Reproductive Health Care Technology's Response to a Changing Legal Landscape

Each year, the Mary and Michael Jaharis Health Law Institute, in collaboration with the College of Law's Center for Intellectual Property Law & Information Technology (CIPLIT[®]), explores a critical legal issue at the intersection of health law, intellectual property law and information technology. Fittingly, this year's symposium explores the seismic shift in the legal regulation of reproductive technologies and health services in the wake of the U.S. Supreme Court decision in *Dobbs v Jackson Women's Health*.

Our interdisciplinary program brings together academics, legal practitioners and health care professionals to discuss these challenges and opportunities by taking an in-depth look at the wide-ranging legal effects and overall impact these radical changes will have on reproductive health care law going forward. 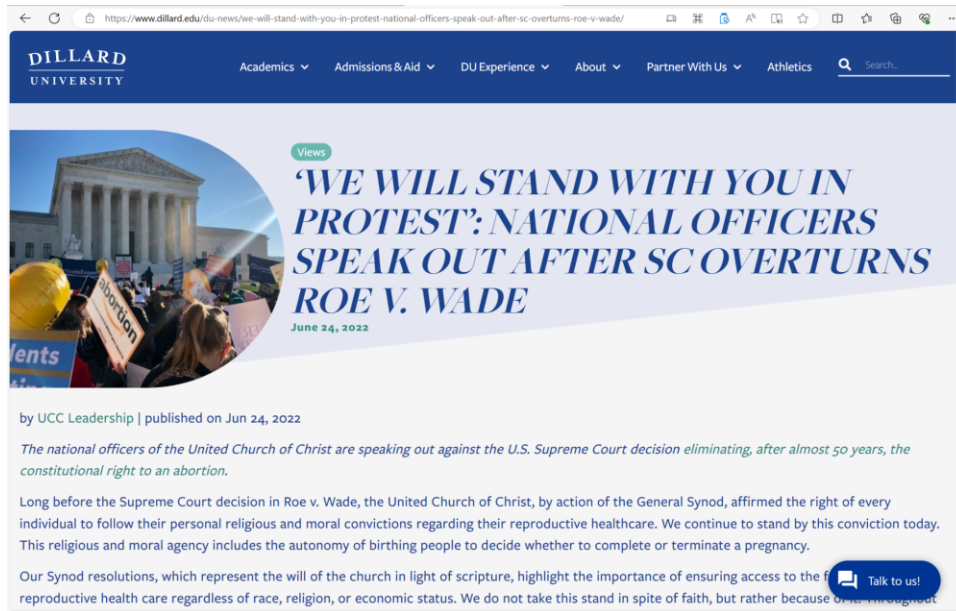

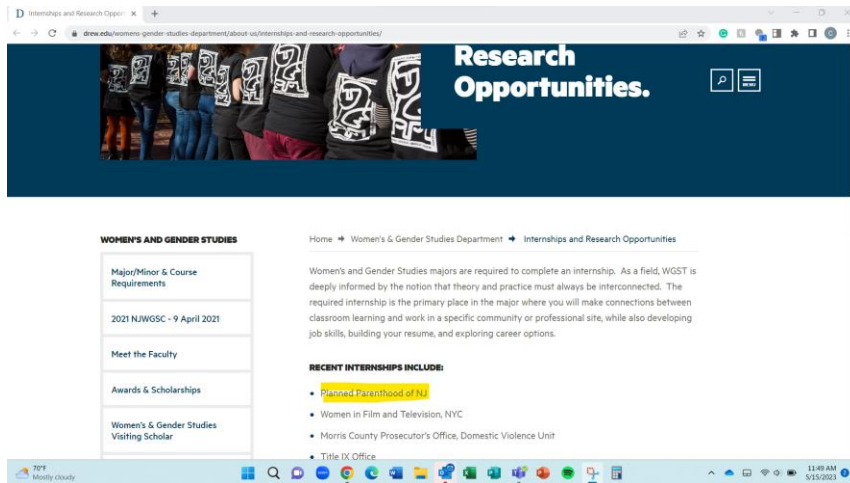

August 18, 2022

President Vincent E. Price released the following statement regarding the reinstatement of North Carolina's ban on abortions after 20 weeks.

Abortion is both a health care procedure and a profoundly personal and highly political issue that prompts deeply held and conflicting convictions on our campus, in our community, and across our country. With that in mind, I want to reaffirm Duke's core responsibilities to serve our students, faculty, staff and patients.

As an educational institution, Duke has a responsibility to advance learning within an environment of respect and inclusion. We must recognize that many of our students, faculty, staff and neighbors have experienced fear and uncertainty about their future access to reproductive health in the wake of the Supreme Court's Dobbs decision in June—anxiety that this reinstatement are likely to deepen. Let us remember to approach one another with compassion in this uncertain moment.

As a health system that serves tens of thousands of residents of North Carolina and the southeast, Duke has a responsibility to provide high-quality and often lifesaving patient care, promote health equity, and support patients in making health decisions with their doctors. **Duke Health will continue to provide reproductive health services, including abortion, in compliance with state law.**

STD Testing

The Campus Health Clinic offers Confidential STD Testing for male and female students. The fees for STD testing are an exam fee and lab testing fees.

Since OCU does not have an on-site lab, blood tests and other laboratory tests are available for a fee for each test that is to be performed. Private Insurance can be billed for the lab fees.

The exam includes a thorough medical history, examination by the provider, collection of specimens (other than blood), and counseling on sexually transmitted diseases. Please inquire about individual tests and fees at your appointment or by calling us at 405-208-5090. We have the capability of testing for all STD's including HIV.

Exam prices are subject to change; **please call** the clinic at 405-373-2400 for the most **current pricing** information.

Other Options

1. There is an STD Clinic offered through the **Oklahoma City/County Health Department** for a \$15.00 fee. The Health Department is at 921 NE 23rd Street (the corner of NE 23rd and Kelly) and the phone number is 405-425-4430. The \$20.00 fee covers the exam and all testing that needs to be done. This is a good idea for students who do not have health insurance or who do not want to come to the Campus Health Clinic for testing.
2. **Planned Parenthood** offers STD screenings to both men and women. Their fees vary. Call Planned Parenthood for more information: 405-528-2157.

Emergency Contraception

(aka, **Plan B**, the morning after pill, or EC)

Emergency contraception is birth control that prevents pregnancy after sex. You can use emergency contraception right away — or **up to five days after sex** — if you think your birth control failed, you didn't use contraception, or you were forced to have sex.

Emergency contraception makes it much **less likely you will get pregnant**. But emergency contraceptives are **not as effective** as birth control that's used before or during sex, like the pill or condoms. So if you are sexually active or planning to be, don't use emergency contraception as your only protection against pregnancy.

Also, emergency contraception **does not protect** against sexually transmitted diseases, like HIV or Chlamydia (only condoms do).

Due to recent legislation passed in Oklahoma, Emergency Contraception is available at a pharmacy without a prescription to

FIGHTING BACK AGAINST DOBBS V. JACKSON
Gender, Sexuality, and Race Studies

GSRs and the Office of DJS Statement on Dobbs v. Jackson Ruling

Dear Community,

On June 24, 2022, we woke up to a different world: a world in which a majority of sitting U.S. Supreme Court justices had turned their backs on more than fifty years of legal precedent to dismantle the constitutional right to privacy and bodily autonomy. The SCOTUS ruling on Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization has created a frightening new reproductive landscape. Abortion care is now illegal in nine states in the U.S., and 17 additional states are expected to ban or significantly limit abortion access in the coming months.

These historic changes to federal and state law will affect close to half of all women and menstruating people living in the United States. Yet we know that these effects will not be distributed or experienced equally. The Dobbs v. Jackson ruling will disproportionately harm communities of color, people living in poverty, and trans and non-binary people.

This ruling is about much more than what Andrea Smith calls the "binary stalemate" of a woman's right to choose versus the protection of fetal life. It is about whose rights are deemed worthy of protection under the U.S. Constitution. It is about how pregnant people and healthcare providers are targeted for criminal prosecution or civil penalty. It is about the failures of our nation-state to support all parents' and all children's access to equitable healthcare and other basic human needs like food and shelter.

We, as faculty and staff of the Gender, Sexuality and Race Studies Program and the Center for Diversity, Justice, & Sustainability, reject this wrongful and persecutory decision. We affirm the basic human right for all people to determine their own lives and govern their own bodies. We support a reproductive political movement that goes beyond the pro-choice / pro-life divide to instead embrace reproductive justice for all.

Scholars and activists Loretta Ross and Rickie Solinger define reproductive justice as:

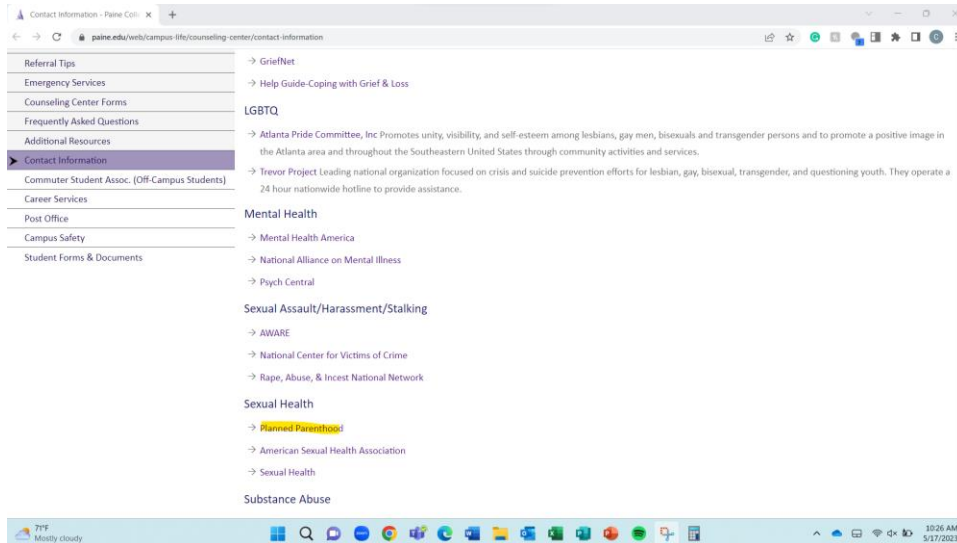
(1) the right not to have a child; (2) the right to have a child; and (3) the right to parent children in safe and healthy environments. In addition, reproductive justice demands that all people have access to reproductive healthcare and that all people have the right to decide for themselves whether and when to have children.

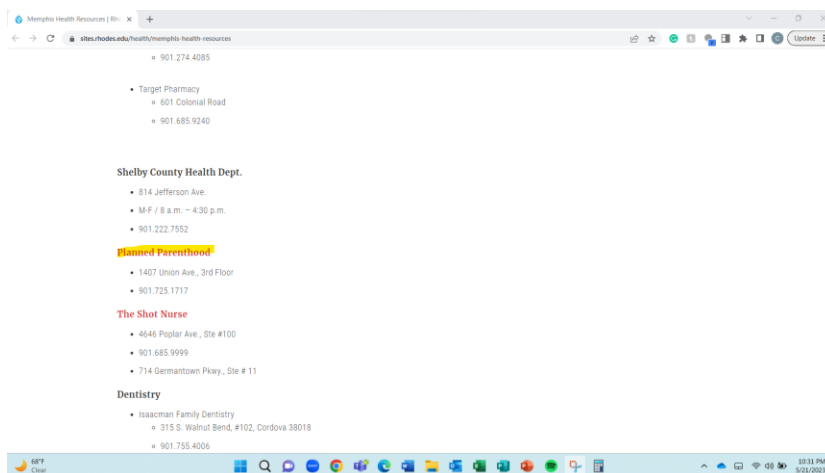
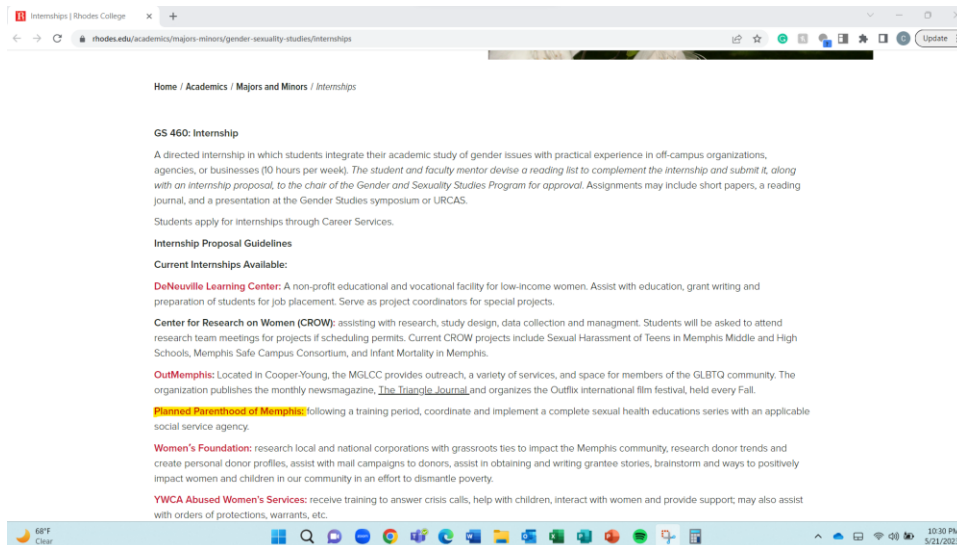

Psychology internships are offered for academic credit and are designed to provide students with the opportunity to gain practical experience in their particular area of interest. Students may enroll in 2-4 credits of PSYC 460, and are expected to spend between 6 and 12 hrs per week on their internship activities over a 14 week semester. Each year, between 10-20 majors (typically seniors and juniors) conduct internships in a variety of environments including the St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, LeBonheur Children's Hospital, Youth Villages, **Planned Parenthood**, Hospice, Girls Inc, the Exceptional Foundation, various law firms, and human resource departments of area businesses.

TIPS FOR TALKING WITH YOUR TEEN ABOUT SEXUALITY

As parents, we really make a difference when we talk with our kids about sex.
Teens who report having positive conversations with their parents about sex are more likely to delay sex, have fewer partners, and use condoms and other forms of birth control when they do have sex.


Here are some tips for making it easier to talk with your teen about sexuality:

Don't be discouraged if you're uncomfortable.
It's common for parents and kids to feel embarrassed or uncomfortable when talking to one another about sex. Owning up to that can help relieve the tension. We might try saying, "It's totally normal that this feels awkward, but I love you and care about you so we need to talk about important things like this." In time and with practice, it will get easier.

Give truthful, useful, and accurate information.
It's important to convey our own values about sex and sexuality. It's also important to prepare our children to make responsible choices whenever they become sexually active. By age 19, seven in 10 teens have already had intercourse. So in addition to conveying our own values regarding sexual relationships, it's important to talk with teens about preventing pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections.

Look for "teachable moments."
Every day, life provides lots of opportunities for talking about sexuality. When watching a TV show that features a young person going through puberty or going out on a date, seeing an ad that prompts thoughts about body acceptance, or running into a pregnant neighbor, we can use that to initiate conversations with our children. Having a starter can make the conversation more natural.

Teens often name their parents as the biggest influence in their decisions about sex.
