



# Christian Schools Project 2025 Report

## OVERVIEW

Students for Life of America's Demetree Institute for Pro-Life Advancement investigated 725 colleges and universities affiliated with Christian churches in the United States for the fourth year in a row, finding that 114, or **more than one in seven** Christian schools had some type of relationship with the abortion industry in general or the nation's largest abortion vendor, Planned Parenthood, specifically.

A little more than one in four degree-granting institutions of higher education claim a faith affiliation, noted the [National Center of Education Statistics](#). Of the 849 considered "religiously affiliated," IPA narrowed the list to examine the schools that identify with a faith-focused, traditional perspective and excluded schools from denominations that support abortion. (The methodology is described in the next section.)

For parents, alumni, donors, and constituents of faith-based campus life and communities, an expectation that colleges and universities bearing the name "Christian" uphold Christian values is central to their investment in those institutions. Most significant is the trust given to schools for instructing the next generation of leaders in the community. If committed constituents of a school cannot even depend on those bearing the name of Christ to stand for **Life**, how can they expect the schools to shape future generations according to Scripture? The annual Christian Schools Project uncovers whether Christian colleges and universities uphold their stated Christian values regarding preborn babies and their mothers, as seen in their support for Life -- or for abortion.

**New findings by IPA have uncovered the tragic reality that Christian schools have increased their support of Planned Parenthood by 19.82% since the 2022 Roe v. Wade reversal.**

A painstaking investigation into each school's website revealed an alarming number of pro-abortion internships, promoted events, and class resources, along with advertised "health" resources, volunteer opportunities, and general support of abortion.

Yet, while many Christian schools are forsaking the values most of their students, alumni, and supporters uphold, others are demonstrating what it means to be the hands and feet of Jesus.

This year's report explores the tension between those schools rising towards Life and those plummeting towards death. IPA's research highlights which schools are Christian in name only and which are true to their namesake.

The goal of the Christian Schools Project is to raise public awareness of Christian schools' abortion industry ties to encourage those schools to restore their Christian values. Without this strategy, the culture of death will continue infiltrating these schools.

At the time of publication, **fifty ties between Christian schools and Planned Parenthood were severed during 2024-2025**, thanks to interventions and awareness facilitated by the Christian Schools Project. Students, parents, alumni, and supporters of Christian schools deserve — and demand — that the most basic Christian value of Life, prevails.

## ADDITIONAL FINDINGS

- More than **one in seven Christian schools maintain** some type of **relationship with Planned Parenthood** or the abortion industry.
- Christian **schools earning an A+ grade** by supporting their local pregnancy center **increased by 13.79% since 2024**, with 25 new A+ schools!
- Christian **schools' support for abortion increased by 19.82% since 2022** in the wake of Roe's reversal; Christian schools' support for abortion increased by 38.63% since 2024.
- More than one-fourth (26.45%) of the infractions overall were Christian schools referring students to Planned Parenthood as a "health resource."
- Over half of the denominations (54.5%) had at least one school with an infraction.

## METHODOLOGY

Students for Life of America's Strategic Initiatives Team conducted research throughout the 2024-2025 school year.

For the scope of this research, a "Christian school" was defined as an institution of higher education affiliated with a Christ-centered denomination and publicly claiming historical

Christian faith in its founding. SFLA identified 725 colleges and universities in the United States that aligned with this definition. To compile this list, SFLA referred to established online resources such as [Niche’s 2024 Best Christian Colleges in America](#) and the [USCCB's Catalog of Catholic Colleges and Universities in the United States](#). Those schools from denominations embracing a pro-abortion stance, such as the Disciples of Christ, United Church of Christ, Quaker, and Moravian were excluded.

Additionally, each institution's mission statement and historical background were reviewed to ensure their identification with Christian values before inclusion in the final list of 725 Christian colleges and universities.

The number of Christian schools on the 2025 list was slightly fewer than the 2024 report due to school closures, some schools removing their faith affiliation, and certain denominations adopting a pro-abortion stance.

To assess a school's connection to Planned Parenthood or the abortion industry in general, researchers conducted a thorough analysis of the school’s website.

Once researchers identified a connection to Planned Parenthood or the abortion industry, a time-stamped screenshot was captured and saved as evidence of the location and type of infraction. Researchers also documented whether the school had connections to nonviolent abortion alternatives, such as local pregnancy centers.

Final research was confirmed throughout June 2025, and personal outreach to the school was conducted between July 1 and July 30, 2025. Respective school administrations or related academic departments were contacted via phone and email. Our team informed them of the identified infractions and requested the removal of the offending content.

## Infraction Categories

An “infraction” denoted a relationship with Planned Parenthood or another abortion industry entity. A variety of connections qualified as a “relationship,” organized in the following categories:

- Schools actively promoted an **internship opportunity** that recommended or credited work at Planned Parenthood or another local abortion vendor on the school’s website.
- Planned Parenthood or another local abortion vendor was publicized as a **health resource** where students could procure services.
- Planned Parenthood was identified as a **class resource**.
- **Events** featuring Planned Parenthood or an abortion industry entity from 2020 onward were advertised on the school’s website.

- Schools promoted **volunteer opportunities** with Planned Parenthood or other local abortion vendors.
- The school administration or an academic department (e.g., “Women and Gender Studies”) **published direct support** of Planned Parenthood or abortion in general.
- Another form of support for Planned Parenthood and/or the abortion industry was found on the school’s website.

The research team gave infractions to Christian schools that engaged in the above forms of relationship with the abortion industry and assigned each school a grade from A+ to F, based on the number of infractions. Repeated instances of the same type of infraction resulted in separate infractions. For example, if there were two different locations where a pro-abortion internship was promoted on a school’s website, this counted as two separate infractions.

If researchers found no infractions (resulting in an A grade), they considered schools for promotion to A+ if the institution also referred pregnant and parenting students to a local pregnancy center.

#### Grading Scale

Grade	Definition
A+	A school with zero infractions and a relationship with a local, life-affirming pregnancy center
A	A school with zero infractions but no proof of relationship with a local, life-affirming pregnancy center
B	A school with one infraction
C	A school with two infractions
D	A school with three infractions
F	A school with four or more infractions

### A+ Promotion Opportunity

The research team also emailed all grade A schools to request the promotion of pregnant and parenting student resources to the student body, enabling schools to later join the prestigious A+ Christian Schools List. To be awarded the A+ Christian School Award, these Christian colleges were responsible for providing web-based evidence of at least one of the following life-affirming criteria:

- Promotion of their local pregnancy center as a resource on their website.
- Promotion of job and volunteer opportunities at pregnancy centers.
- Establishment of scholarships for pregnant and parenting students.

- Partnership with Standing With You, an SFLA initiative that supports pregnant and parenting students, by promoting [www.standingwithyou.org](http://www.standingwithyou.org) as a pregnancy resource.

## KEY FINDINGS

### 1. More than one in seven Christian colleges and universities maintain some type of relationship with Planned Parenthood and the abortion industry.

Out of the 725 total Christian schools investigated, **118 schools were initially found to have ties with Planned Parenthood or support abortion.** The schools shared a combined total of 533 infractions, **up 115.79% from last year.** After contact with researchers in July 2025, 4 schools removed all connections and 4 additional schools removed some connections, resulting in 114 remaining schools with connections. Since 2024, 50 connections to the abortion industry have been removed from Christian campuses.

Of the remaining 114 schools with infractions, 47 received a F grade (for four or more infractions), 10 received a D grade (for three infractions), 19 received a C grade (for two infractions), and the remaining 38 schools received a B grade (for one infraction). The number of schools that received an F significantly increased by nearly 96%. California and Illinois tied for most schools with infractions, with 10 such schools each.

Since 2024:

- The percentage of schools with an A grade decreased by 6.85%.
- The percentage of schools with a B grade increased by 58.79%.
- The percentage of schools with a C grade decreased by 2.96%.
- The percentage of schools with a D grade decreased by 31%.
- The percentage of schools with an F grade increased by 96.36%.

### 2025 Top 10 Worst Schools

The following 10 schools have completely forsaken their Christian values in terms of abortion. While these are not the only schools behaving in ways contrary to Biblical values, they are the worst offenders in terms of infractions.

1. American University (DC)
  - a. Denomination: Methodist

- b. # of infractions: 34
  - c. Worst Infraction: The Youth Empowerment and Reproductive Health in New Orleans, Louisiana Spring Alternative Break program includes working with Planned Parenthood.
- 2. Duke University (NC):
  - a. Denomination: Methodist
  - b. # of infractions: 27
  - c. Worst infraction: A campus event featured a panel discussing the legal, medical, and personal perspectives on abortion access, including a team "advocating for patient access to safe abortions."
- 3. Dickinson College (PA)
  - a. Denomination: Methodist
  - b. # of infractions: 23
  - c. Worst infraction: Planned Parenthood is listed as an internship opportunity for 6 different majors.
- 4. Macalester College (MN)
  - a. Denomination: Presbyterian Church (USA)
  - b. # of infractions: 23
  - c. Worst infraction: The Hamre Center for Health and Wellness states in a Reproductive Justice Statement that "all-options "counseling is provided for students, "including referring patients for pregnancy termination to local resources."
- 5. Rhodes College (TN)
  - a. Denomination: Presbyterian Church (USA)
  - b. # of infractions: 20
  - c. Worst infraction: Planned Parenthood is listed as an internship opportunity for eight different majors.
- 6. Emory University (GA)
  - a. Denomination: Methodist
  - b. # of infractions: 19
  - c. Worst infraction: RISE, a reproductive justice research network, is co-leading a study "with the goal of improving abortion access."
- 7. Hope College (MI)
  - a. Denomination: Reformed Church in America (Other)
  - b. # of infractions: 14
  - c. Worst infraction: Abortion counselor is listed as a possible career for sociology majors.
- 8. Southern Methodist University (TX)

- a. Denomination: Methodist
  - b. # of infractions: 14
  - c. Worst infraction: Planned Parenthood is listed under pregnancy and parenting resources.
- 9. Augsburg University (MN)
  - a. Denomination: Lutheran
  - b. # of infractions: 13
  - c. Worst infraction: Planned Parenthood, Whole Women's Health, Family Tree Clinic, and All Options are listed as resources for unplanned pregnancy in the student support guide.
- 10. Otterbein University (OH)
  - a. Denomination: Methodist
  - b. # of infractions: 10
  - c. Worst infraction: Planned Parenthood is listed as a possible employer after graduation for two different majors.

## **2. Christian schools earning an A+ grade by supporting their local Pregnancy Center increased by 13.79% since 2024, with 25 new A+ schools!**

Thankfully, dozens of Christian schools are exemplifying Biblical values. The remaining 610 Christian schools received an A or A+ rating because there were no infractions found on their websites. Within that segment, **66 improved to an A+ for listing their local pregnancy center on their school website, which was a 13.49% increase from 2024.** Texas had the most A and A+ schools, with 36 A schools and 9 A+ schools. The following states had no schools with infractions: Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Kansas, Maine, Maryland, Mississippi, New Hampshire, North Dakota, Oregon, Rhode Island, South Dakota, Utah, Vermont, and Wyoming.

### **2025 Top Ten Best Schools**

- 1) Abilene Christian University (TX)
  - a. Denomination: Churches of Christ
  - b. The university removed Planned Parenthood as an internship opportunity in 2025. The university also lists a pregnancy center as an off-campus resource for pregnancy and a local mission opportunity.
- 2) Aquinas College (MI)
  - a. Denomination: Catholic
  - b. The college lists the pregnancy center under “Community Resources and Basic Needs” and lists Bethany Christian Services as a pregnancy/childbirth support resource.

- 3) Belmont Abbey College (NC)
  - a. Denomination: Catholic
  - b. The college features MiraVia's College Residence for pregnant students.
- 4) Benedictine College (KS)
  - a. Denomination: Catholic
  - b. The college lists the numerous pregnancy resources and post-abortion resources in the student handbook, has a webpage for the pro-life mission, and has a pro-life leadership program for high school students.
- 5) Central Christian College of Kansas (KS)
  - a. Denomination: Methodist
  - b. The college lists Standing With You and Open Door Health Services under Pregnancy Center/Parenting Support resources.
- 6) DeSales University (PA)
  - a. Denomination: Catholic
  - b. The university lists numerous pregnancy resources including Standing With You under Title IX Pregnant/Parenting.
- 7) Liberty University (VA)
  - a. Denomination: Nondenominational/Evangelical
  - b. The university lists Standing With You and pregnancy centers under "Pregnancy and Parenting Student Resources" on their website.
- 8) Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary (TX)
  - a. Denomination: Baptist
  - b. The school has a pregnancy center on campus.
- 9) University of Dayton (OH)
  - a. Denomination: Catholic
  - b. The university has a program of support and care for single, pregnant students.
- 10) University of Mary (ND)
  - a. Denomination: Catholic
  - b. The Saint Teresa of Calcutta Community is an on-campus housing and resource center for single mothers.

### **3. Christian schools' support for abortion increased by 19.82% since 2022 in the wake of Roe's reversal, with a 38.63% increase since 2024.**

Our 2023 report found:

With the historic reversal of *Roe v Wade*, the subject of abortion was launched into America's public dialogue at levels likely not seen since 1973. Those "in the middle" were pulled out of their silence, and many forfeited unquestioned abortion support amid hostile environments. Thus, 2022 also became a decision year for Christian schools: to apply or not to apply God's truth on the value of life. In 2021, the conclusion of our Christian school outreach found 69 schools in total having

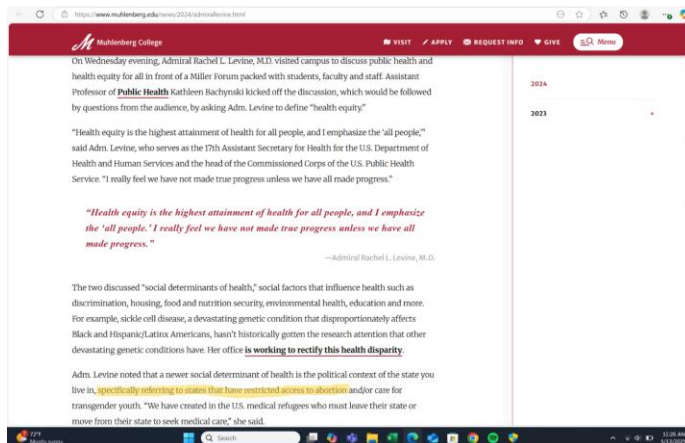


infractions by the end of that year. However, following the Dobbs decision in 2022, schools with infractions skyrocketed back up to 76 in total throughout the following year, increasing by nearly 10%.

One year later, we found Christian schools on the same trajectory, with 83 schools with infractions, another nearly 10% increase.

Now, two years later, **we find Christian schools increasingly forsaking their values, now with 114 schools with infractions, a nearly 20% increase.**

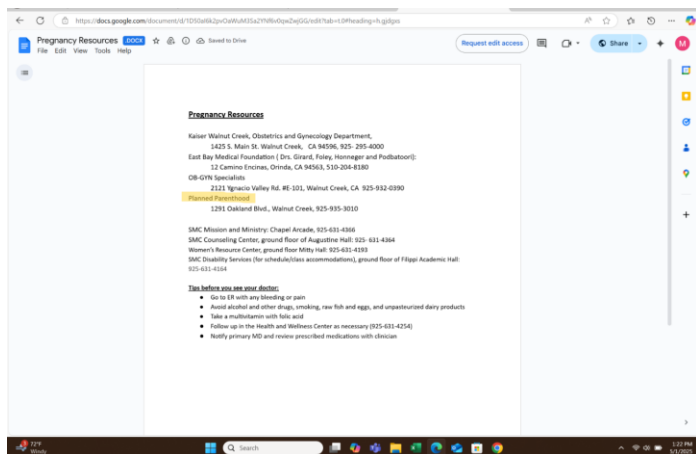
The abortion lobby's behemoth presence during 2024 elections likely contributed to this increase. With the most pro-abortion Democratic presidential ticket in history, pro-abortion messaging abounded. In addition, ten states had abortion-related referendums on their ballots to force late-term abortion into their states' constitutions. Not surprisingly, blue states like California and Illinois tied for most schools with infractions at 10 schools each. Hope College, a Reformed Church in American school in the state of Michigan, hosted a campus event promoting Proposal 3, a constitutional amendment protecting reproductive rights. Muhlenberg College, a Lutheran school in Pennsylvania, hosted transgender U.S. Assistant Secretary for Health Admiral Rachel L. Levine, who discussed restricted access to abortion.



**4. Over one-fourth (26.45%) of the infractions overall were Christian schools referring students to Planned Parenthood as a "health resource." While this is still the most common infraction, it decreased by 36.87% from 2024. The next most common infraction consisted of class resources followed by internship opportunities.**

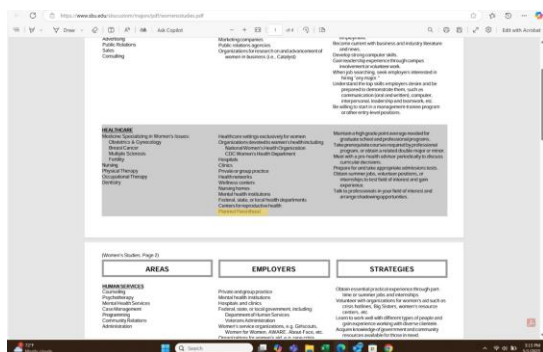
The abortion lobby's insistence that abortion is healthcare has also caused several schools to stumble. **Over one-fourth (26.45%) of all documented infractions promoted Planned Parenthood to students by listing the abortion vendor as a 'reliable and trusted health resource either from the school health center's landing page directly, or within a**

**linked document of local resources.** Not only do multiple schools list Planned Parenthood as a health resource, but several schools also go a step further and list Planned Parenthood as a pregnancy resource. Illinois Wesleyan University, a Methodist school in Illinois, lists Planned Parenthood as a pregnancy/parenting student resource. Saint Mary's College of California, a Catholic school in California, lists Planned Parenthood as pregnancy resource alongside OGGYN specialists.



## CLASS RESOURCES

**Class resources accounted for the second most common infraction (25.52%).** These include listings of potential career opportunities, articles, references, and partnerships. Many were found on homepages for women's/gender/sexuality studies. St. Bonaventure University, a Catholic school in New York, lists Planned Parenthood and "abortion clinics" as future employers for women's studies majors.

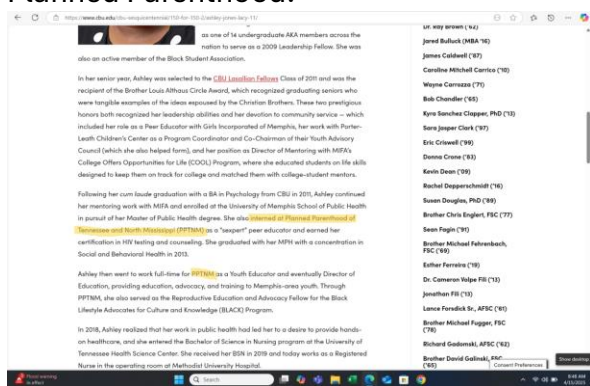


## INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

**Internships accounted for the third most common infraction (22.7%).** 82 new internship infractions were found in 2025. These were largely found on schools' career development platforms, such as Career Edge or CareerHub. While Planned Parenthood was the most

common internship opportunity found, other organizations within the abortion industry appeared. Loyola Marymount University, a Catholic school in California, featured the following internship opportunities on their Career and Professional Development webpage: Planned Parenthood, NARAL, Reproductive Freedom for All, National Latina Institute for Reproductive Health, and Ibis Reproductive Health.

An especially notable finding this year was a focus on pro-abortion alumni. Sixteen new infractions included mentions of alumni and/or featured alumni who have ties with the abortion industry. Christian schools should be focusing on alumni who exemplify shared Christian values, not those who are antithetical to Christian teaching. Christian Brothers University, a Catholic school in Tennessee, highlighted an alumnus who interned at Planned Parenthood as a “sexpert peer educator” and eventually worked full time for Planned Parenthood.



## 5. Over half of denominations (54.5%) had at least one school with an infraction.

The abortion lobby’s propaganda has resulted in not just one wayward denomination, but rather a majority of them. **In the 22 denomination categories researched, 12 contained schools with infractions.** Infractions were found within the following denominations: African Methodist Episcopal, Baptist, Catholic, Church of the Brethren, Episcopal, Interdenominational, Lutheran, Methodist, Nondenominational/Evangelical, Other, Presbyterian, and Seventh Day Adventist.

**The Methodist denomination accounted for 36.84% of infractions, the highest percent of total infractions across all denominations.** Within the Methodist denomination, 46.15% of schools had infractions. 2025 results showed 7 schools lost their “A” grade and two lost their “A+” grade.

Most shockingly, a portion of Catholic schools have forsaken their Christian values and rejected the following Catechism of the Church: "Since the first century, the Church has affirmed the moral evil of every procured abortion. This teaching has not changed and remains unchangeable. Direct abortion, that is to say, abortion willed either as an end or a

means, is gravely contrary to the moral law" (No. 2271).<sup>1</sup> **In 2025, Catholic schools accounted for 24.56% of total infractions across all denominations, a 19.92% increase since 2024.** Within the Catholic denomination, 12.67% of schools had infractions, a 66.29% increase since 2024. **Despite this, Catholic schools also had 24 “A+” schools, the most of any denomination.**

Infractions were not found within the following denominations: Assemblies of God, Church of God, Churches of Christ, Evangelical, Mennonite, Mormon, Multidenominational, Nazarene, Pentecostal, and Wesleyan.

## 2025 VICTORIES

**After initial contact with our researchers in 2025,  
8 Christian schools removed some or all ties to the abortion industry.**

Of the initial 118 schools with infractions contacted, 3.39% responded and removed their infractions. Sometimes, this resulted in schools elevating back up to an “A” grade, removing all Planned Parenthood and abortion references from their website. In other cases, schools with multiple infractions only removed one out of several references, thereby resulting in an improved grade and noted “victory,” but not an “A” grade.

While some schools replied to our team’s outreach and confirmed the removal of an infraction, other schools quietly removed a reference. After the deadline for schools to remove the identified references had passed, our team reviewed each infraction link again to verify whether the content remained online.

### 2025 Christian School Victories

- 1) **Abilene Christian University** (TX) – Removed Planned Parenthood as an internship opportunity.
- 2) **Alverno College** (WI)- Removed Planned Parenthood as an off-campus resource.
- 3) **DePaul University** (IL) – Stopped a BDSM Sex Ed event hosted by Planned Parenthood Generation Action.
- 4) **Saint Mary's University of Minnesota** (MN) – Removed Planned Parenthood as an employer on the Career Services webpage.

- 5) **Fresno Pacific University** (CA) – Removed the National Women's Law Center, who promotes abortion, as a Pregnant/Parenting student resource under Title IX
- 6) **Notre Dame de Namur University** (CA) – Removed Planned Parenthood as a health resource for undergraduate students.
- 7) **Presbyterian College** (SC) – Removed Planned Parenthood as a top nonprofit in the Nonprofit Career Guide.
- 8) **University of St. Thomas** (MN)- Removed Planned Parenthood and other pro-abortion organizations from their Career Development webpage. They also provided a guide to removing pro-abortion internships for other schools!

## CONCLUSION

A pro-abortion mindset has increasingly clouded Christian schools' judgment as evidenced by this year's report. There were 114 Christian schools that abandoned the most basic Biblical value, the sanctity and intrinsic value of human Life. Supporting and facilitating abortions is neither loving thy neighbor nor educating future disciples on gospel truths.

All Christians must unite and demand basic biblical values are upheld at higher learning institutions across the nation. If we cannot trust these schools to teach the most basic value of Life, how can we expect them to form future generations according to Christian principals? And, if we do not take action, what does that say about our own values as Christians?

**Christian schools can rise to Life instead of dying to darkness.**

**One hundred total abortion connections have been removed from Christian schools since the start of this project in 2021.** Wayward schools can come back home and become life-affirming institutions once again. As more and more Christian schools return to the light, the pro-life movement can more easily change the entire landscape of United States higher education. Demanding Christian schools teach the most basic Christian value of Life, the pro-life movement helps abolish abortion, one wayward institution at a time.

The Demetree Institute for Pro-Life Advancement, powered by Students for Life of America, will continue to amplify these issues through our Christian Schools Project, seeking resolutions. In addition, an investment must be made to change culture from within by

starting Students for Life groups at every Christian school, which is an essential part of Students for Life of America's National Campus Expansion Plan.
